- Portal Crossing LERP units Last month the board voted to allow local business owners to qualify as potential buyers to purchase the upcoming LERP units at Portal Crossing (formerly the Sunset Hotel) to house employees. - Winter Water Service If you think that your water lines are in danger of freezing, please contact Town Hall to get a bleeder valve by Dec. 1. Bleeder valves keep a constant flow of water through your service line without an additional charge to your account. Learn more:

- Fall and Hunting Season It is hunting season in Colorado. If you are going on a hike in the woods, make sure that you're highly visible and keep your pets on a leash. And, as we all know, when the hunters go up into the mountains, the wildlife comes down to the roads. Be careful driving, especially around dusk.
- RMNP Seeks Public Input for Long-Range Day Use Visitor Access The park experienced a 44 percent increase in visitation from 2012 to 2019. In 2021, the park received 4.4 million visits. Even with a timed entry system in place the park received some of the highest visitation in its history. A plan is needed to provide day use visitor access in a way that protects resources while creating opportunities for high-quality visitor experiences. The park will host a public open house on Tuesday, November 14, from 5 to 7 p.m. at the Grand Lake Center. WORRIED ABOUT YOUR WATER PIPES FREEZING IN THE WINTER?

The Town of Grand Lake offers "bleeder" valves to qualifying properties to prevent service lines from freezing. Units using bleeders may be granted a credit against the water bill for the amount of water allowed to be bled.

GOT A BLEEDER VALVE?

Remember to have them inspected by a plumber to make sure they are ready to go for the winter. Bleeders may be turned on December 1st.
