- Water Certifications Two of our water department employees just received new water distribution certifications. We are very proud of all of the work that our staff does to keep up to date in order to provide top notch service to our residents!
- Snow Plowing The Public Works team conducts snow removal activities when the Town receives 4+ inches of snow in a single storm event. Unfortunately, plowing does require that a berm is built on the side of the road. We will try to minimize this berm when it crosses driveways, however, it is the responsibility of individual homeowners to clear the berm themselves. Public Works cannot clear private driveways.

- LERP Applications The Town is accepting applications for the upcoming Local Employee Residence Program housing units, Located at the Portal Crossing development. Nomination Petitions Received

The Town Clerk received one completed and verified Nomination Petition for the Mayor Vacancy and three completed and verified Nomination Petitions for three of the four Trustee Vacancies. There were no "Write-in Candidates".

Candidate Meeting

On Tuesday, February 6th at 10 a.m. there will be a candidate meeting at Grand Lake Town Hall to determine the ballot position by lot draw.

Upcoming Deadlines

February 16th, 2024 is the deadline for clerk to mail ballot and ballot materials to an person listed as an active military or overseas voter (UOCAVA) in statewide voter list.

Absentee Ballot Reminder

Please visit the Town website if you need the application for an "Absentee Ballot" and submit to Alayna Carrell, Town Clerk. Applications must be filed with the municipal clerk no later than four days before the election (the Friday immediately preceding such election).

Looking for an affordable trash service? Try Grand Lake's Pay-As-You-Throw (PAYT) trash program!

The PAYT trash program provides trash services for a variety of users in the Grand Lake area who may not subscribe to trash pick-up services. This self-service, drop-off facility is designated for prepurchased bags ONLY.

The drop-off facility is located across from the Post Office, behind the car wash (address: 601 Center Dr., Grand Lake, CO 80447). All items disposed of must be in a pre-purchased PAYT bag.

Bags can be purchased at Grand Lake Hardware, Grand Lake Center, Mountain Market, Conoco and Town Hall.

Fees (inc. tax):
25-gallon (blue bags) - \$5 each
40-gallon (green bags) - \$8 each

Sulphur Ranger District to Host Open Houses

The Sulphur Ranger District will host a bi-monthly open house from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. on the first and third Thursday of every month, starting Feb. 1 at the Forest Service office in Granby. District Ranger Eric Freels and other Forest Service staff will be available to answer questions and talk about National Forest management and upcoming forest projects.

The Forest's information hub remains the best way to get immediate assistance from Forest Service specialists on any topic, from trip planning to passes and permits. To schedule an appointment or contact a specialist, email VisitARP@usda.gov or call 970-295-6600 and press 0 for assistance. Campground reservations and other permits can be found on recreation.gov. Items such as passes, maps and reservations will not be sold at the open houses.
